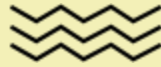

But I carved your name on every side

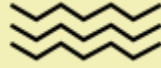

It's not a choice that I need sleeping on

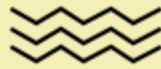

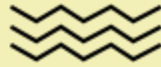

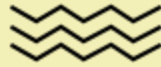

The words that it chose are the ones that it needs

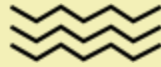
I only see

End Up Here



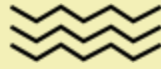
I can't say that we'll end up rich

Silence is thunder

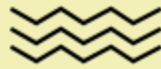
Have you ever considered

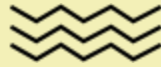

If only a small piece of dirt to begin from

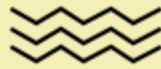
But I shouldn't have anything to show for who I've been
